# 1. EMPOWERMENT OF CHILDREN AND YOUNGSTERS WITH DISABILITY



***JMJSSS community disability offers the provision of services to individuals with disabilities by collaborating, linking, and creating platforms to be responsible and empathetic community members.***

- In the month of March 2021, JMJSSS conducted an awareness program called 'We Ring the Bell' for inclusive education, which ensures quality without considering issues such as capability, ethnicity, culture family background, and disabilities. Motivate the children to respect diverse groups to grow side by side to the benefit of all.
- Due to the COVID-19 Lockdown period Community Rehabilitation, Physiotherapy exercises, and Identification Activities were carried out by video calls for 15 disabled children.
- Community Rehabilitator monitored and guided the parents to improve ADL Skills for 8 Children to follow the routine, maintain a clean home, and learn to communicate.



- Entitlements: Many children applied for Disabled Certificates three of them completed the process and received the certificate.
- Provisions provided to the families of disabled children during the pandemic period.
- On Sep 18th, 2021, JMJSSS invited to felicitate Ms. Mumtaz Pathan the Chairman for AP Differently Abled & Aged Persons. Sr.Denin explained the activities of JMJSSS towards Differently Abled children and the Aged.



- In the month of Aug 2021, the COVID-19 awareness program was conducted and Hygiene Kits were distributed to 82 disabled children. CBR worker explained how to use Sanitizer, Mask And encouraged them to maintain social distancing.
- in the month of August, JMJSSS distributed Medical Kits for members, who were suffering from COVID-19 and under Quarantine at Sathenapalli
- in the month of Aug 23rd JMJSSS conducted a program to Distribute Fruits to COVID-19-affected children who are in quarantine at Adivi Thakkellapadu.

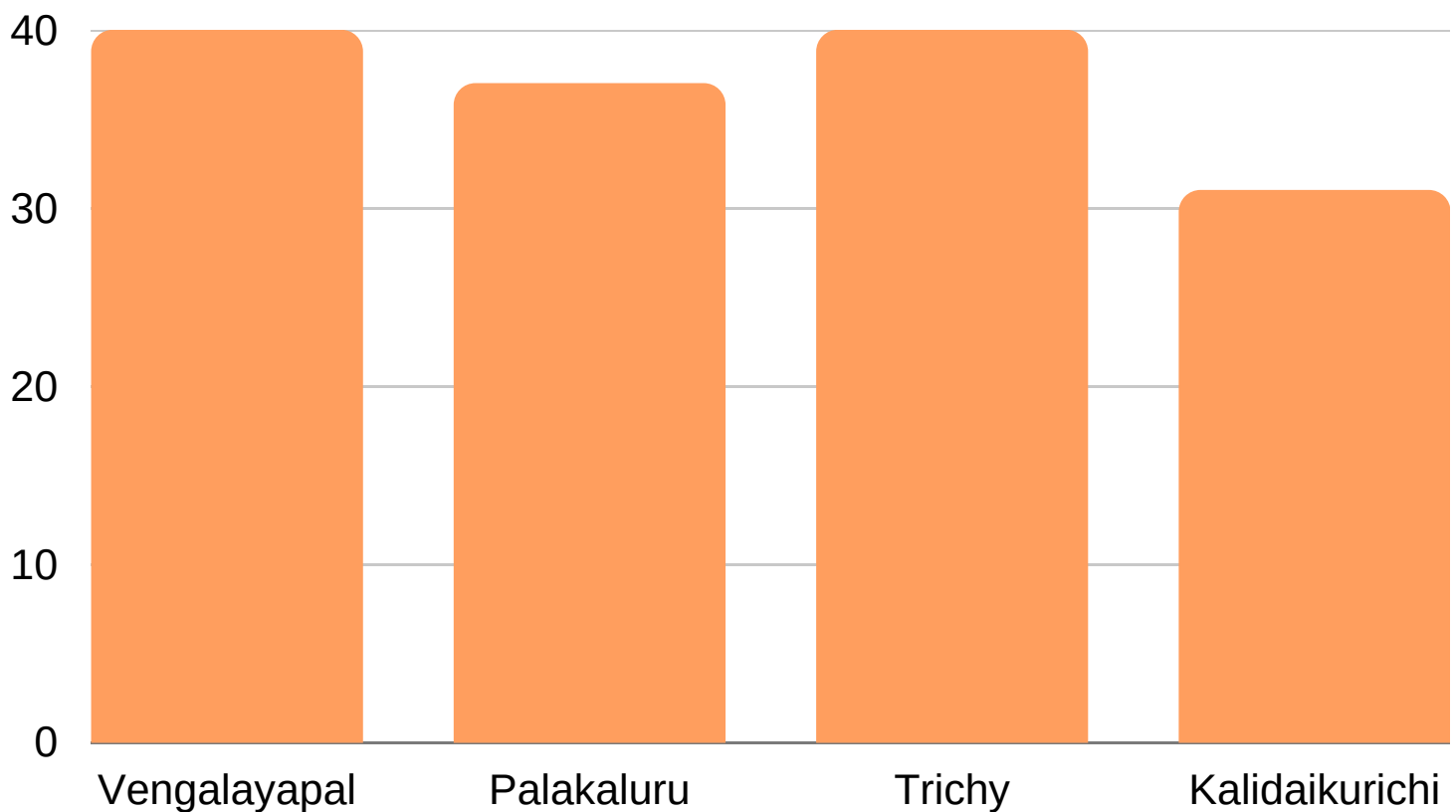

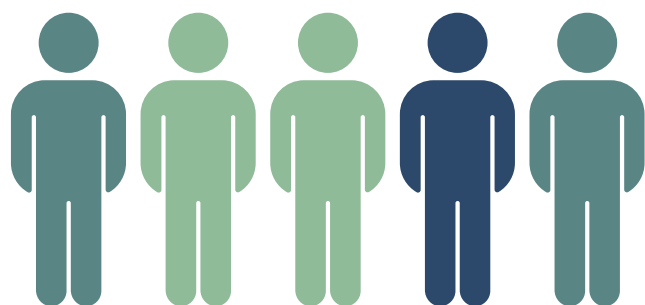

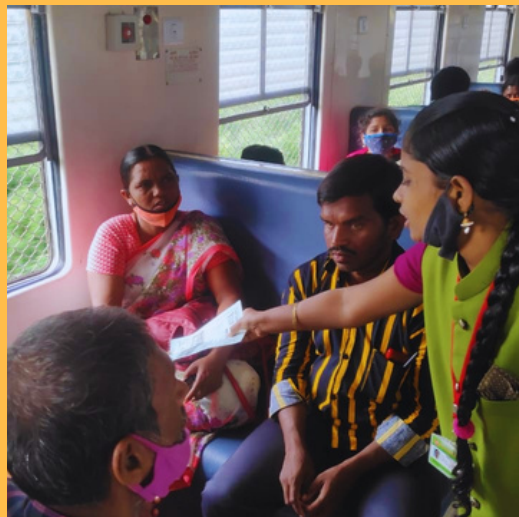

### 3. CHILD LINE

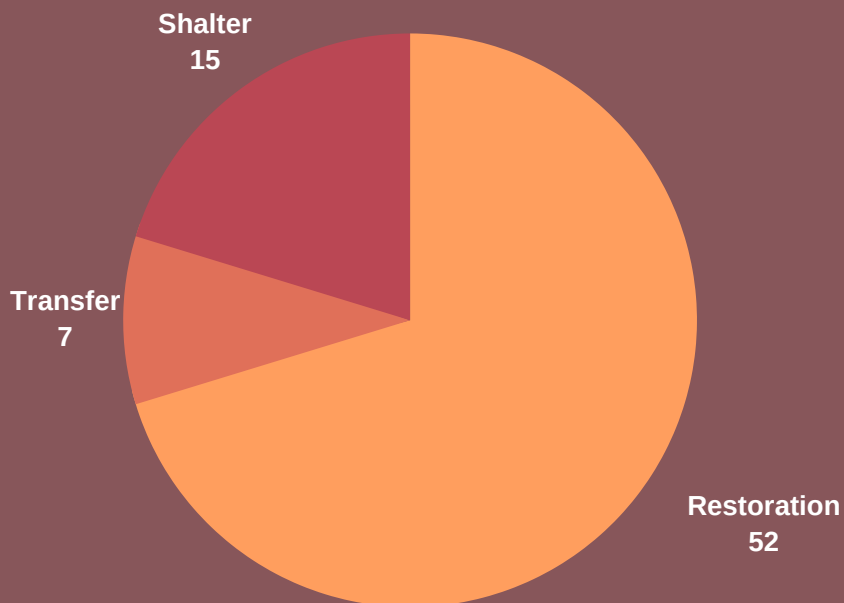


***The CHIDLINER HELP DESK – Ministry of Railways & WCD-CHIDLINER INDIA Foundation Implemented by JMJ Social Service Society, Nallapadu. CHIDLINER works for the protection of the rights of all children aged from 0 to 18. It is an initiative for rescuing and assisting children in distress. The particular focus is on all children in need of care and protection, especially the more vulnerable sections and including Victims of child sexual abuse***

Child Help Desk is initiated in Guntur Railway Station. It was Inaugurated by South Central Railway, Guntur Division DRM, Mr. R. Mohan Raja, and JMJ Guntur Province Provincial Rev. Sr.Tresa. In this program all Rly. Allied Systems, Child Welfare Committee, Rotary Club Members, JMJ Social Service Society Staff and. The entire Child Help Desk Team participated.

- this Team consists of Co-Ordinator, Counselor, seven team leaders and three Volunteers who are working 24/7 on a shift basis.
- Counsellor Counsel rescued the child and provide emotional support. It is very helpful to collect the details of the child and their parents.
- The rescued child is produced before the child welfare committee by the child help desk staff. The committee collects the details of the child and his parents. Finally, the child was restored to his parents in the presence of the Child Welfare Committee based on the relevant documents of the child.
- The Child Help Desk Team Member gives awareness about Child Line (1098) services to the passengers in the train and on the platform every

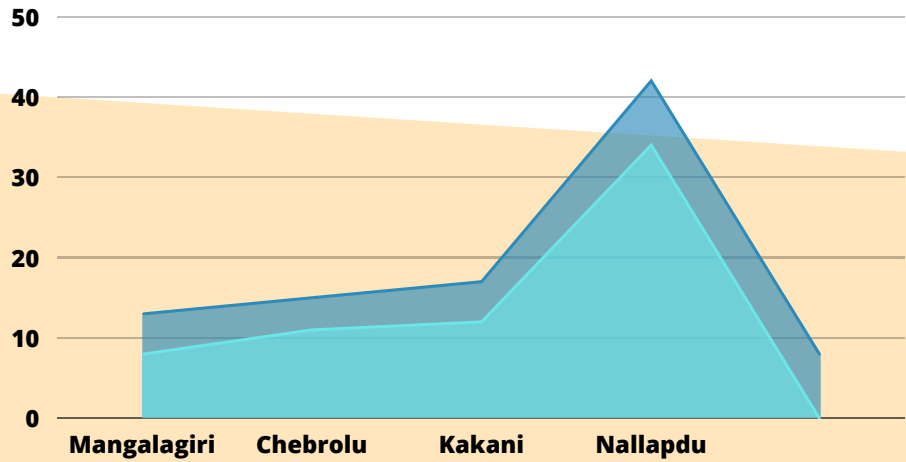

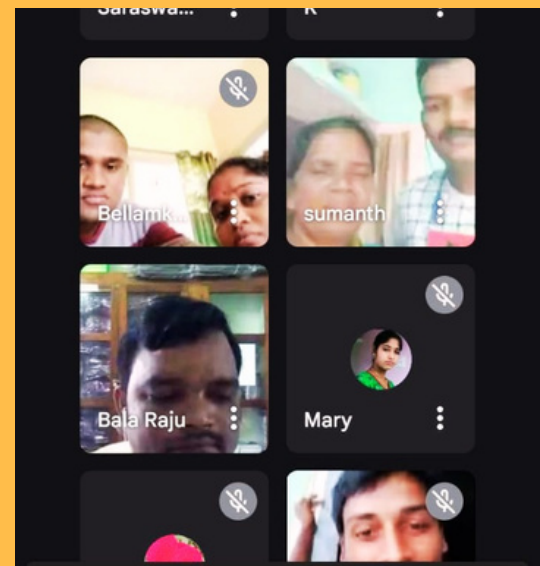
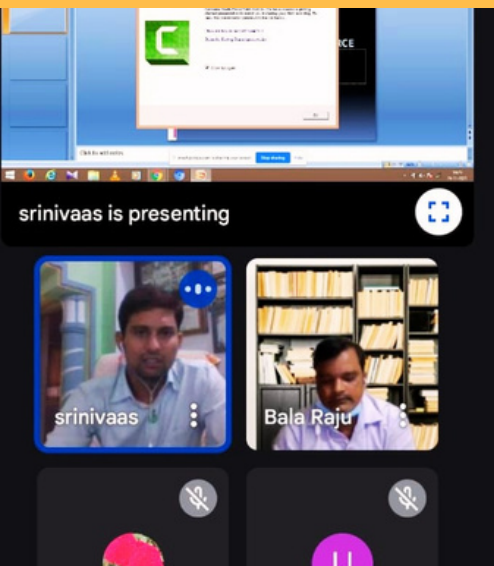
# 7. SKILL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM FOR YOUTH

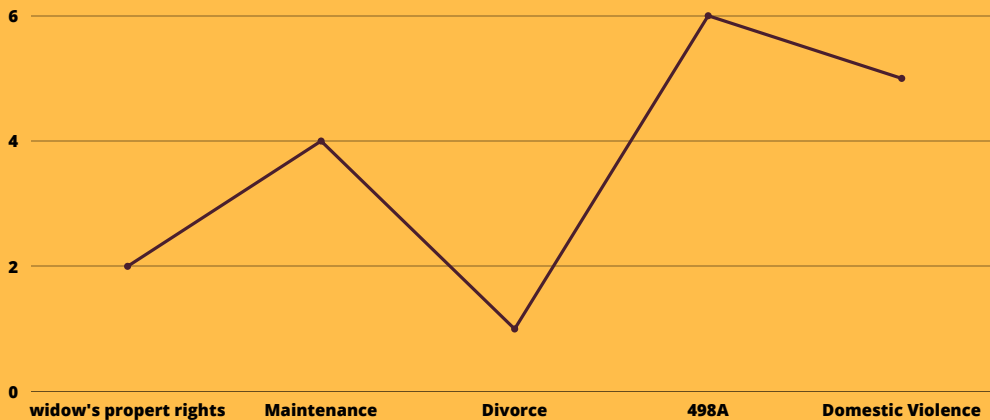
I Chelsia, have completed Intermediate. My parents both passed away.

My sister has the responsibility to take care of me as well as my education. So, she could not afford to continue my further studies. As I am at home without a job, I came to know about Skilling India. Then I visited the center at JMJSSS and expressed my interest to join in an E-commerce course. I can grasp the lessons taught in class and do my work on time.

Hence, I achieved a job at Child Help Desk, Rly. Station, Guntur.

## 8. THE LEGAL AID CELL AT JMJSSS



*No. of Cases -  
Legal Aid*

***A part-time legal practitioner with 6 years of experience and with the support of senior advocates to address on average 15 -20 cases per annum. Most of the cases are civil in nature, specifically matrimonial disputes(Domestic Violence, 498A, Divorce, Maintenance, widow's property rights, etc.) a few land disputes, criminal and POCSO(Prevention of Children from sexual offences-Child marriages prevention, Child sexual abuse, minor children) cases. Most of the cases are addressed free of cost or charging very nominal fees which cover court, documentation, and travel expenses. Most of the matrimonial disputes are settled outside the court at JMJSSS- Legal Aid Cell by way of summoning both the parties & counseling. When the parties determine to go through the legal process, a reference for the legal proceedings is made.***

- Accomplishments:** People who approach us are poor, rural, illiterate, innocent, and ignorant and cannot afford to bear the court & advocates fees. Sometimes people come to us at the end when everything is lost, in hopeless situations. They are easily exploited by most of the advocates outside who charge high fees for their ends to be met. It is obvious that the lay advocates have chosen this profession for their livelihood whereas when I look at this profession it is partaking in the Manifesto of Jesus 'to bring liberation to the captives' and 'to bring Justice for the poor and people in genuine need.

## 9. VILLAGE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM



***JMJSSS adopted the backward tribal villages in Guntur and Ramachandrapuram where the rural development programs were not effectively implemented by the government machinery and to prepare a comprehensive Microplan for Holistic development of tribal communities involving all stakeholders in a participatory mode to meet the needs of the village community.***

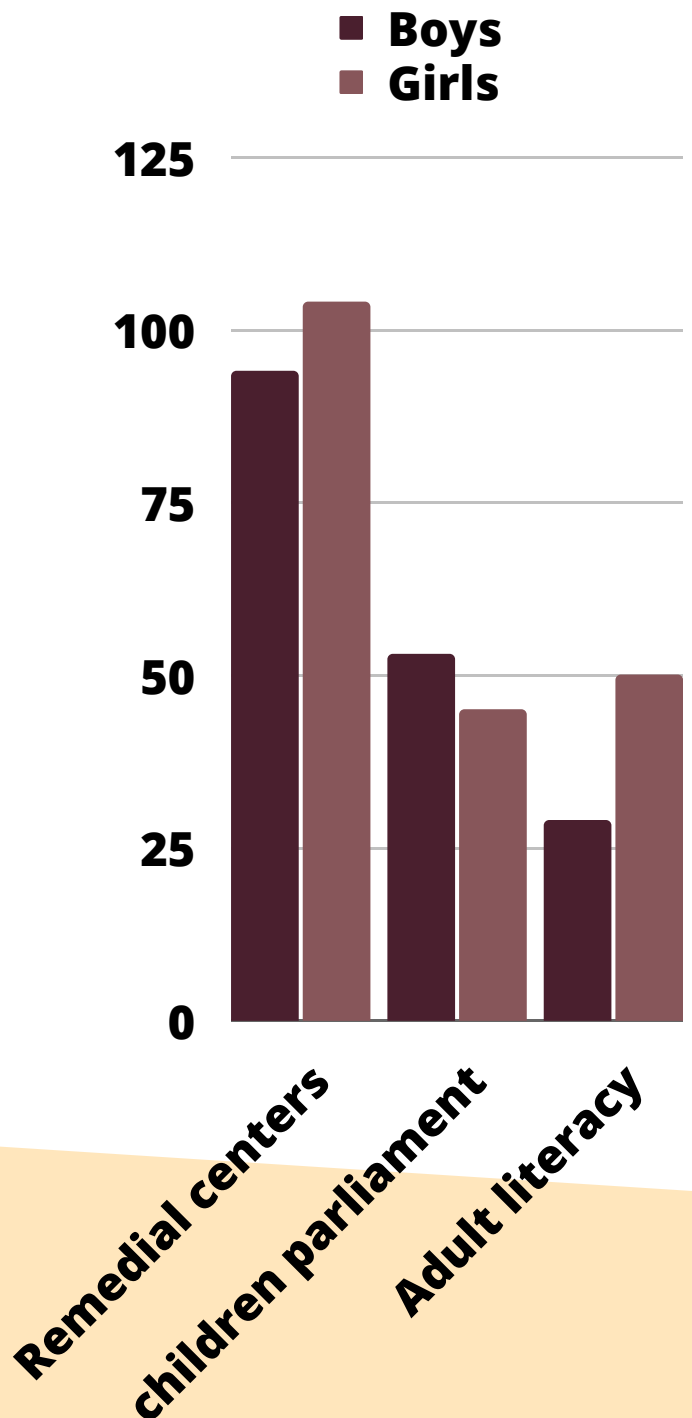
- **Leadership:** Monthly VDC & FDGs meetings focusing mainly on village and family development ideas, plans, and implementations in every village.

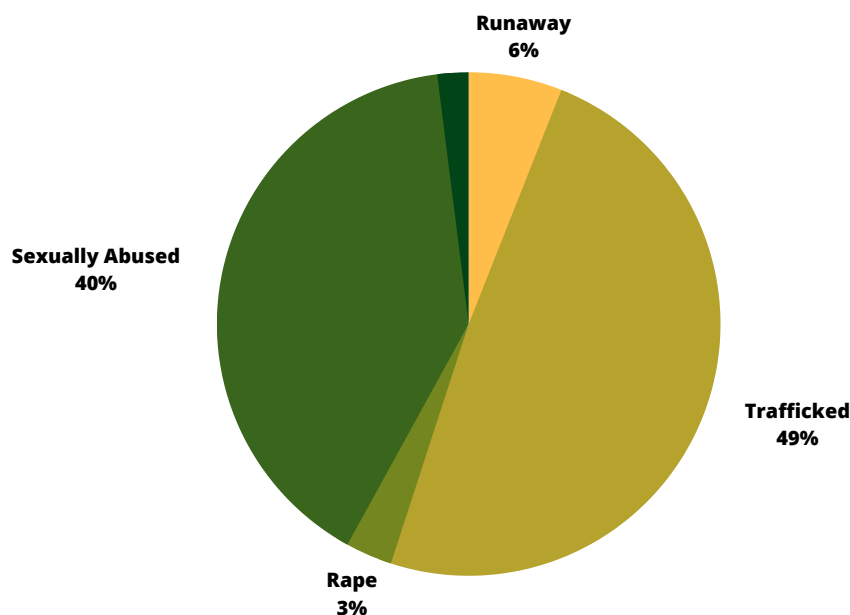
## 2. JMJ UJJWALA HOME FOR THE TRAFFICKED WOMEN

My name is Lakshmi. From the age of 15, I was forced to get into prostitution. I was caught by the police after 2 years took me to JMJ UJJWALA home. In the beginning, I felt difficult to adjust. But as the days passed, I felt at home and living peacefully. I got training to develop skills in tailoring. I learned to stitch all types of bags, Churidars, and blouses. Now and then my mother came to see me. Now I'm convinced that I can live with my mother and earn a living. I asked my mother to apply to the court to get the relieving letter. At the age of 19, I went with my mother. I was able to take care of my mother and sustain my earnings. In UJJWALA other than skills I learned many things. Especially, I trained my personality and to live in a society with values. I can stand to live happily with my earnings. And improved my character and personal behavior.

### 3. JMJ SWADHAR HOME FOR WOMEN IN DIFFICULT CIRCUMSTANCES



**A Scheme for Rescue of Victims of Trafficking and Women in Difficult Circumstances like widows deserted by family, survivors of natural disasters, victims of domestic violence, victims of trafficking, released from jail, etc.”**

A celebration of life is not making ourselves happy. But making others happy is a real celebration.

JMJ Swadhar inmates are creative in thinking and making beautiful and colorful items. Especially in Art making, preparing key chains in various models, pouches are prepared with beads, and these items are exhibited in various places to win the confidence of each other.

Inmates are interested in cultivating vegetables, green leaves, fruits, and flowers on our Swadhar premises. Each one is trying to make a place in heaven.

Swadhar inmates are privileged to have booster doses in Tenali.

In the month of May, our Swadhar inmates went to Hyderabad and visited many places like Charminar, Ramoji film city Golkonda, etc. Everyone enjoyed maximum with all the new places.

Rehabilitation of the Inmates: From March 2021 to April 2022 We received 37 inmates and in the same duration we rehabilitated 7 inmates.

MY NAME IS SRIDHAR SAI PRIYANKA. MY FATHER'S NAME IS SRINIVAS RAO. I AM TWENTY-ONE YEARS OLD. I AM FROM NARSAROPET, GUNTUR (DT).

When I was 10 years old, I lost my father. I came to Swadhar in the year 2015, and when I was fifteen years old, I got married. For a few months I happily led my life and as the days pass on I was torched physically and mentally so could not bear that, so I ran away from my husband. I informed my mother. And she joined me in Swadhar home. Since then, I was staying in Swadhar and happily led my life. I am trained in all the skill training works like tailoring, stitching, making fiber bags and thread bangles, etc. Our Sisters also taught me how to speak and to lead my life. After coming to Swadhar I have completed my Inter and Certificate courses which will help me to live a dignified life. When I came to Swadhar I was too stubborn and there were times when I used very harsh words to my peer group and to the management. But the sisters through their counseling helped me to change myself, they gave me lots of hope and encouragement in my life. My mother and my grandmother had confidence in me. They have arranged a marriage for me. I am happy because Swadhar sisters helped me a lot in my life and helped me to stand on my feet and face society courageously. I am always indebted to the sisters and to the Swadhar home.

## 4. PRAJWALA SWADHAR HOME



**PRAJWALA help individuals recognize their inner potential and celebrate life by developing their self-worth. The path chosen for this is equipping the participants to deal with their emotional, cognitive, aesthetic, and spiritual dimensions of life. This is achieved through counseling, training, concertizing, and empowering.**

- Skill training for sustainability, This year training was given on Candle, Surf, Phenyl making Tie and Dye, Printing, Jute bags and Paper plate making.
- Celebrations: Celebration of birthdays of the children, other festival days like Pongal, Ganesh, Gandhi Jayanthi, Deepavali, Christmas, New Year, and Independence Day.

I was happy and now I want to go out and live by myself and take care of my children, After the counseling, I became strong to take any decision for me and for my future whatever it may be I am ready to face so I went out and living with my children and I married my husband also came we were together now I am thankful to all whoever helped me, especially I was grateful to Prajwala JMJ Swadhar home staff and all inmates really I was happy I have learned many things for life.

.KAKILETI. ROJA RANI, IS 17 YEARS OLD HER FATHER'S NAME IS RAJKUMAR, AND HER MOTHER'S NAME IS UMA MAHESHWARI, AND THEY ARE LIVING IN HYDERABAD.

Roja rani's parents fell in love and got married against the wishes of their parents. They live in rented houses in Hyderabad and went for daily wages, her father died due to his illness. Mother used to work and took care of her child. Roja rani's mother had extra marital status with Radhakrishna and shifted their family to Y.S.R. colony Vijayawada. Both married at church, and they were living happily. Roja rani was joined in the 10th class at ZPH school YSR colony. After two months her mother Uma Maheshwari died of a heart attack, from then Radhakrishna is taking care of raja rani. After two months he also left roja rani in the house and went off. Some of their neighbors knowing the situation took care of her for a few days, some have her problem was noticed by the class teacher and informed the city child line, and they produce to the Child Welfare committee and refer to Prajwala home on 03/11/2021. After coming the home, counseling was given to motivate her to concentrate on her studies. After completing the 10th class exam, the District Magistrate, DCPO Sir, and In charge of Prajwala home decided to transfer the girl to Hyderabad CWC and keep her in any home and continued her studies and get her father's property for Roja Rani.

## 6. JMJ HOME FOR THE AGED, DURGI



**It is initiated mainly to care for the poor and deserving aged people. All the needs of this home are met by our Province. Local benefactors occasionally contribute paddy, and food for the inmates. We do help the lepers who reside in a colony at Macharla. Once a month visit them or if necessary, give them medical care, help them with small repairs etc.**

The main apostolate of St. Ignatius Convent Durgis caring for the aged and doing evangelization. The main motto of the starting of Home for the aged is to take care of the economically poor and needy. All the maintenance for the inmates is met by the Province. And local benefactors contribute on special occasions with paddy, clothes, and food.

We provide all the facilities and take care of them as small kids. We provide nutritious food to keep them healthy. We also give them the monthly required cosmetics such as soaps, oil, paste, brush...etc. We arrange Dhobi to wash their clothes. We have a dedicated Nurse Sister who oversees the home for the aged. If they are sick immediate care is given and takes to the nearby private hospital. Regular medicine is provided to sick people. In the home, we provide them with the necessary furniture to sit and relax. They play indoor games and regularly watch TV is part of recreation. We have a big campus with a variety of plants and flowers. They do admire nature. Regular prayers to strengthen them spiritually and Individual hygiene also is cared. Some of the inmates help in doing vegetable cutting and plucking the flowers.

Some of them who joined in the Home remain till their death and their funeral rights are taken care of us. Inmates are very happy and are ever faithful to the service of the sisters.

## 7. JMJ SSS NILAYAM, KONDRAMUTLA



Providing a hostel for SC, ST & BC girls at present 95 tribal students are accommodated in the hostel for children of 1st Class to 1st to 5th standard. Primary education, good shelter, Nutritious food, and taking care of their health. Taking extra care of those who are unable to read and write and speak with others. Inmates were trained in cultivating the fruits and vegetable Garden They show their interest in cultivating their own vegetables and Green leafy vegetables also grew up in the flower garden too. All the needs of this home are met by our Province. Little contribution from children also is added.

**Celebrations:** Celebration of birthdays of our children and other festival days. Pongal festival is celebrated as a thanksgiving ceremony for the year's harvest on the 15th of January 2021 in our Hostel. On 14th November 2021, we had the celebration of Children's Day (Jawaharlal Nehru's Birthday) at the RCM School at Kondramutla. On the 2nd of October 2021 Gandhi Jayanthi, Celebrated in our hostel.

**Old People:** In the month of December 2021, we organized a gathering of 70 old and destitute from 3 villages and we invited our Parish priest and local donors along with our parishioners, Parents of our children. We conducted a semi-Christmas program for them, like prayer, skit, and songs, with cake-cutting and Tea & samosa. Finally distributed the clothes such as saris, blouses, Shirt and do to the 70 old & destitute.

Kitchen Garden was encouraged by distributing the vegetable seeds and fruits in 9 villages nearly 2000 families and the School campus/ Church campus. Through MRO & Divisional Forest Officer, we got 2000 plants like Gova and Mangoes. In the month 2000 plants were distributed to villages and encouraged Tree plantation. Gave awareness to the villagers and made them plant in the aground the village, Near Homes and School campus. Skill Development Program for Women, Widows, Destitute and Girls Tailoring Programme for women. We have conducted tailoring training for the 20 women, and widows. This training is very helpful to them to gain skills and sustain their life in the coming future. Starting in November 2021, JMJSS Nilayam is initiated to support 20 Widow and deserted women families to improve socio-economic conditions, Leadership, Education, Health, Livelihood, and values in a self-sustainable way.

Naga Mani bai belongs to a tribal family from Koppukonda Thanda. Parents were illiterate and they go to work in different places, and they come back once in three months. She joined as a first-class student in 2018. She has less IQ power and she speaks very few words as the days passed, she learned to mingle with other children and try to speak and understand things. She also learns how to read and write and improved her powerful way of talking with other students and her reading skills. She has improved a lot in her studies. At present, she is going to appear in the gurukula patasala entrance test. Parents are happy by seeing their child's good behavior, changes, learning capacities, and developments.



# ACTIVITIES IN ZONAL UNIT-TAMILNADU

# 1. JMJ HOME FOR THE DISABLED, TRICHY



- Physiotherapy exercises have been done for Reshma, child no. 146 who is in the photo. And, for 5 children have done every month, which has strengthened the body. Passive stretching exercise and Active resisted exercise for strengthening, balancing exercise for sitting and standing, coordination exercises, and walking training without any support.
- Family counseling to the parents of Monisha- Child No. 206, and also 5 children's families. Regarding positive thinking and changing their attitude. Monisha is a 17-year-old child with an MR disability. Her parents are both coolie workers and struggle to make ends meet. They hail from a very poor background and cannot provide the basic necessities for their children. Monisha has an elder brother in good condition.
- ADL Skills: Have done for 7 children. COVID Awareness giving to children know about the Covid situation. For understanding shown with the picture of Identification.
- Skill Development: Skill development courses on Tailoring for Lavanya and knitting baskets for Hepsiba and Lavanya for 6 months



**We helped 3 children by distributing dresses and food materials and medicine amount.**

**We helped 5 children Sowndarya, Harini, Kaveri, Jennifer, and Kanishka by providing a UDID card.**

**We helped 2 children-Ramzan Beevi and Dhaswith by providing dress and food materials, Medicine amount, and Tuition Fees.**

- Disability Day: On 2nd December we took our children's vocational Centre for MR adult home to participate in the disability day. One of our deaf and dumb girls danced karakattam. Trichy district DDRO Mr. Chandra Mohan was our chief guest he gave a speech about the importance of Disabled children and he appreciate all the talents. They gave prizes for all our children. On the 3rd JMJ Disability home with our inmates, we celebrated disability day and distribute the prizes.

## 2. EMPOWERMENT OF CHILDREN AND YOUNGSTERS WITH DISABILITY, KALLIDAIKURICHI



Since it was lockdown due to the corona we could not go to their houses. In spite of the lockdown, the Physio doctor could teach the physio exercise to their mothers through WhatsApp. For those who couldn't afford a smartphone, we visited their houses following the Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) of the Corona protocol. As JMJ SSS in Kallidaikurichi is in the nascent stage we are trying to do our best to reach out to the poor in need. Further, through CHAI we got a food kit. We distributed them to the families of Different able children. We also gave awareness about the Covid-19 pandemic to their parents and their neighbors

- Tailoring: We the JMJ Sisters started the tailoring Centre at Potal and Singampattion on July 20, 2021, with the help of VRO. The JMJ sisters are working for differently-abled children. The parents are supported with tailoring training it is organized with the support of the President of the village provided the common buildings. The president was very happy to allow us to use the buildings. Then, we bought the Sewing machines, and we started the tailoring Centre. We appointed the teachers Mrs.Mariamamma and Mrs.Murgamma (a widow). The women were happy to come to our Centre. At present women are learning tailoring. They are very great full to our service.



**Covid-19 Awareness Program:** The JMJ Sisters had planned to give awareness about Corona Virus Disease -2019 (Covid-19) to the children and the general public. The sisters had the plan to give awareness about COVID-19. First Our target is our tuition children and their parents. We joined with the Magic show group which was spreading awareness about Covid-19 through a musical program. They brought the “Parai”(the musical instrument) and played to gather the people in a particular place. The sound of the instrument caught everyone’s attention. The children rushed to us happily. We also participated in the acting.

**Independence Day-2021:** We celebrated the 75th of Independence Day of India. We remembered the great sacrifices of our freedom fighters. The children gathered were gathered together in their own places at Potal, Sembaruthimatu, and Kallidaikurichi. They had a flag hosting ceremony, accompanied by the singing of the National anthem and various Patriotic songs. Everyone honored the National Flag by Saluting the National Flag. The students of three other tuition centers too celebrated Independence Day at their respective places on the same day.

**ADL Training:** Have done for 30 members such as Toilet training, Concentration, Speech Therapy, Household Work, and Daily activities and chores according to their needs.

### 3. EMPOWERMENT OF CHILDREN, YOUNGSTERS, WOMEN, OLD PEOPLE AND DESTITUTE, THECKALUR



For the occasion of schools reopening JMSSS distributed the Bags to the children in the tuition center. The children felt very happy and thankful to the sister. The awareness program was conducted on Children's Rights. The guest explained and gave awareness about the rights.

Conducted VDC Meetings in the village to check the mission topics such as Leadership qualities, Values & Ethics, Household care, Earnings & Finance, and Education. Every VDC member gives explanations about the feedback and bottlenecks.

The children of the village are studying every evening in the remedial centers with the help of Remedial Teachers.

Students are facing difficulty in going to school due to being far away from the home. So, FFVDP sponsored the Bicycles for the girls. Hence, they can go happily to school without fail. The parents and the girls felt very happy and thanked FFVDP.

People were suffering from the Water problem in all the villages as it comes an hour per day. The VDC member expressed the problem to the panchayat president to help the villagers with water facilities. Hence, the president helped the villages within a month with the water pipelines to every house now round the clock they have water.

The village people expressed their gratitude to FFVDP.

In the village, people are suffering to meet daily needs due to a lack of daily work. We approached the women's self-help group (SHG) head to give loans for petty business. Hence, the government helped through SHG that each family got 100 chicks, food, and medicine for them. Totally 9 families got 900 chicks. The Govt. will give 50,000 each when they grow the chicks.

She has discussed more the rights and responsibilities of disabled children, what are facilities given by the government at the block level and district level. She has encouraged more to disabled children, how they will become self-supportive in their life. She inspired the children and the parents with her words. Parents are very grateful to the CHAI-LF. After interaction with parents and children JMJ Convent superior Sr.Amirdha and JMJ Hospitaladministrator Sr. Flowrencedistributed school bags, notebooks, rolls, and pens to each child who benefited from JMJ CHAI-LF.

**Tree plantation for the widow women:** Through the method of teaching saving and kitchen garden we have provided fruit plants and vegetable plants and seeds to the widow women. After receiving the plants immediately, they have planted the tree.



DB Tech skill development program has been conducted in JMJ CCC campus very successfully. The guest addressed 30 students to keep focus to complete the courses and hence get the placements.

World Social workday celebration: The theme of this year 2022 is “Building a new Eco-Social World: Leaving no one behind”. We celebrated World Social Workday 15th March 2022. On this occasion, we visited the villages and celebrated. It was an opportunity for us and others in the social service center to celebrate our achievements as well as to raise awareness and support for the important role that we play in the lives of the children, families and communities facing adversity. It is also reminding us of the needs for future planning, developments and support to the work that we are carrying on in our center.

Home visit to Save a family & SLF Students. As a Social workers, we go for house visiting, to know the family background of our beneficiaries, to collect the documents from them for counseling to know the beneficiaries' family situations, to survey the work that they are doing and how far they are carrying on and to know the areas where it is situated. It is our bounded duty to visit their houses.
