EMPOWERMENT OF CHILDREN AND YOUNGSTERS WITH DISABILITY

JMJSSS community disability offers the provision of services to individuals with disabilities by collaborating, linking, and creating platforms to be responsible and empathetic community members.

On 27.7.22 conducted the We Ring the Bell program at ZPH School, Vengalayapalem, to encourage disabled children for attending school. In this program 250 children of both disabled and normal attended.



ADL Skills:

Follow up of 14 CwDs practicing ADL Skills to manage physical needs, including personal hygiene or grooming, dressing, toileting, transferring or ambulating, and eating, which are monitored by the Community Rehabilitator with the help of their parents which is improving their daily living from much dependence.

Community Rehabilitation

Physiotherapy: We support 14 Disabled children by doing physiotherapy at all stages of life to recover from injury, reduce pain and stiffness, increase mobility and movement, and maximize function and quality of life, incorporating physical, psychological, emotional, and social well-being.

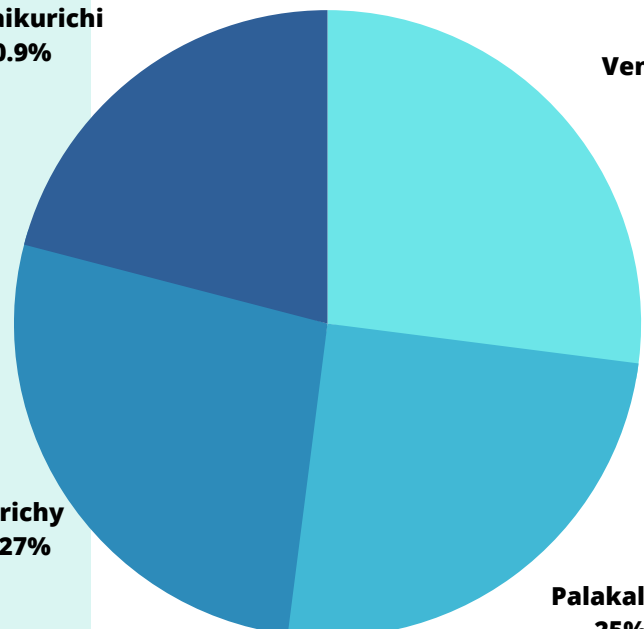

INCLUSIVE NEIGHBORHOOD CHILDREN'S PARLIAMENT

JMJSSS Children's Parliament promotes participation and leadership among children to do advocacy for child rights. They come together, learn together, discuss together, and act together fortnight on issues of children in the village for social change.

The collaboration with 'Hand des Menschen', Mrs. Lina team visited all the children's parliaments. And Mrs. Lina appreciated the children for their performance and encouraged them to study well.

JMJSSS conducted an Awareness program titled 'Cloth Bags for Life' for using cloth bags & Band plastic. All children parliaments of Salapadu, Pedakakani, Nambur, Uppalapadu, Perecharla, and Nudurupadu villages participated. The chief guest Sr.Mary Kumari, Director of JMJSSS addressed that everyone must use cloth bags or jute bags because Govt., has declared to stop using plastic. 1 Plastic bags pollute our land and water. 2. Plastic bags are harmful to wildlife and marine life. 3. Plastic bags are harmful to human health. So, we must follow the Government's instructions, at the end of the program distribute cloth bags to every child. In this program, children learned more about the ban and boon of plastic through group discussions through charts. Finally, the program ended with a meal.



The rally was conducted on “Ban Plastic Use” as an awareness program to protect the environment from pollution. The Ambedkar Children's Parliament participated actively in holding a letter-writing campaign with the guidance of the moderator, the coordinator Mr. Lakshman Children's Parliament, and the remedial teacher Mrs. Savitri also participated in this program.

The Monthly Meeting will be conducted as mock children's parliament, to teach how the legislative body of the government works. Hence they discuss the issues of the children & village and how to solve the problems.

CHILD LINE

The CHILDLINE HELP DESK – Ministry of Railways & WCD-CHILDLINE INDIA Foundation Implemented by JMJ Social Service Society, Nallapadu. CHILDLINE works for the protection of rights of all children aged from 0 to 18. It is an initiative for rescuing and assisting children in distress. The particular focus is on all children in need of care and protection, especially the more vulnerable sections and including Victims of child sexual abuse.

As a part of monthly Awareness programs, conducted at AP Residential School, Adavithakkellapadu, Guntur. In this program Guntur Railway Child line's Coordinator Mr.Kishor addressed that 1098 is a Toll free Number that spells hope for millions of children across India. We reach out to every child in need of care and protection by responding to calls on 1098 and through interventions. 575 school children and the staff of school & child line were participated.



As a Counsellor, Sr. Gloria took Counseling session to help the child, who have faced trauma or personal loss to cope and do better with chronic emotional and psychological problems. And also tried to develop a relationship based on trust to make the child talk about his problems and learn to “manage” them.



Special drives were conducted in the vulnerable trains by Railway Childline with the RPF and GRP police person at Guntur Railway station. these programs were organized for trafficked children in suspected long going trains.

The Open House Meeting has conducted in Pedakakani, with the Theme “find out the children issues in the community level and slum areas”. RLY Child line will resolve the issues of children by the help of government and local leaders.





On 18th May 2022, Child line conducted an Anti-Human Trafficking Awareness program for railway secondary stakeholders along with RPF. As a part of this program GRP C.I Mr.Venkateswaraa Rao, RPF CI Mr.Ramaiah, Childline Nodal Coordinator Mr. Phani Rajendra, and BBA state coordinator Mr. B. Chandra Sekhar are given awareness to secondary stakeholders. In this program housekeeping staff-37, Vendors 22, Porters-4, Passengers-22, and railway child line staff-5 participated.



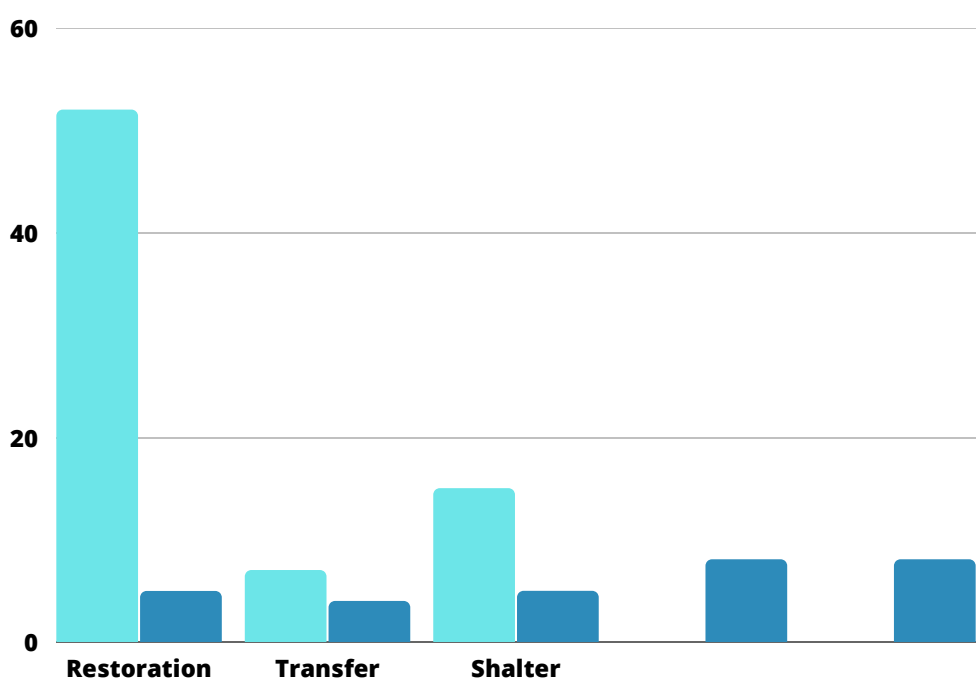

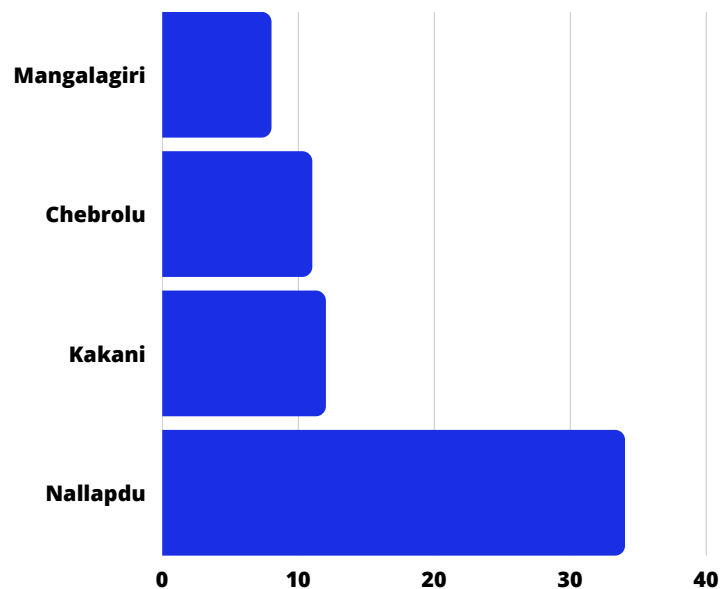

VILLAGE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

JMJSSS adopted the backward tribal villages in Guntur and Ramachandrapuram where the rural development programs were not effectively implemented by the government machinery and to prepare a comprehensive Micro plan for Holistic development of tribal communities involving all stakeholders in a participatory mode to meet the needs of the village community.

Annual Gettogether held grandeur in all 6 villages. In the part of the program conducted games and skits. Finally ended the program with dinner. In this program village elders and Sr.Suseela, Sr.Sumira and all the FFVDP staff participated.

Household care: Community organizer and Field coordinator motivated 173 families to manage waste water by maintaining a kitchen garden.

Health Care: 173 families are motivated safe and clean toilets (doors, electricity, water) 8 toilets constructed. And distributed COVID-19 health toolkit Sanitizations, Masks & Medical kit with immunity, vitamin tablets.



Education: Sensitize on Child Friendly Environment-Hand Wash, nutritious meal, immunization, 63 children in Anganwadi center. They will be monitored by community organizer. Remedial Centre Independence Day celebrations Children playing with Identification game



Earnings and Finances:48 families are benefitted through income generation program which is decided in the VDC.

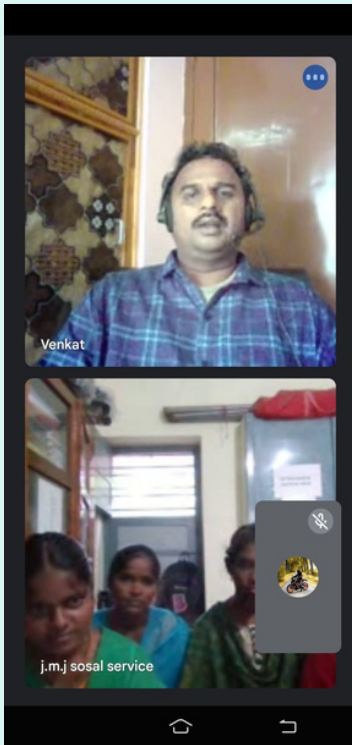
SKILL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM FOR YOUTH

Training class: We train them at vejendla one month by teaching all the procedures of nursing filed to gain knowledge in order to know the care of patient at home as well as in the Hospital.

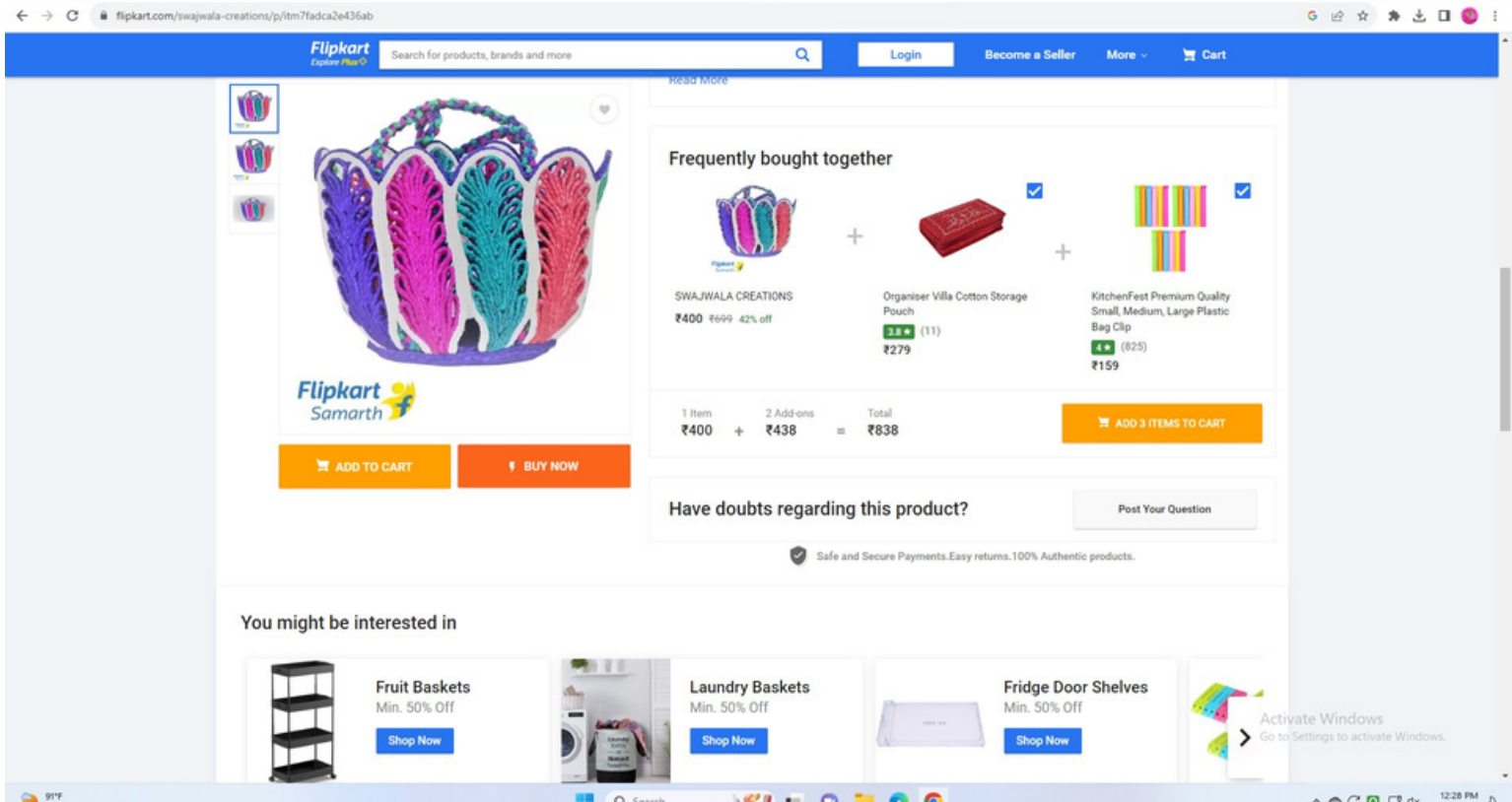

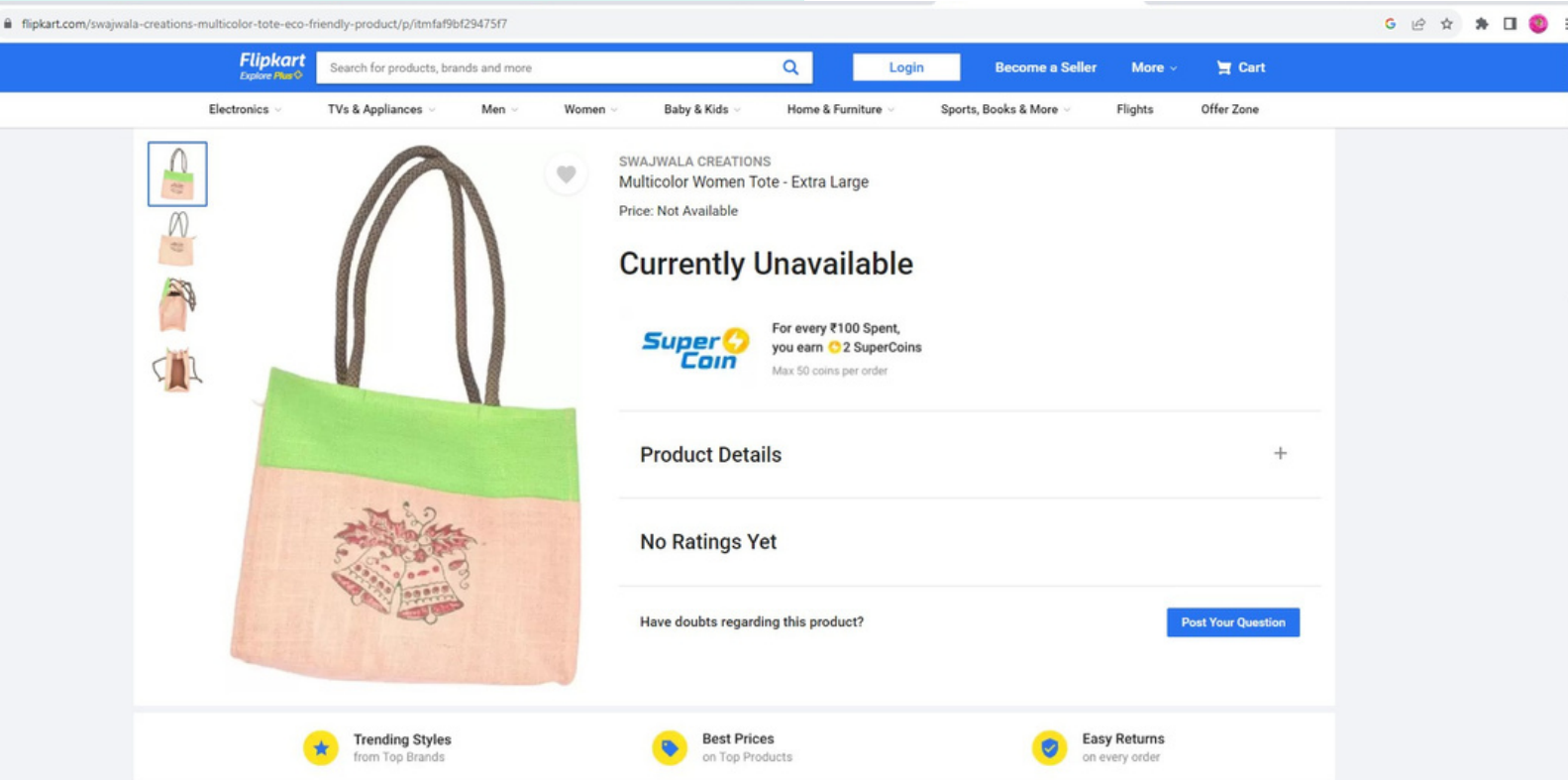
SUCCESS STORY:

JMJ HOME FOR THE AGED AT DURGI

It is initiated mainly to care the poor and deserving aged people. All the needs of this home are met by our Provincialate. Local benefactors occasionally contribute paddy, provide food for the inmates. They are also helping the lepers who reside in a nearby colony. Once a month they visit them, if necessary give them medical care and solve problems like water, repairs etc. We provide all the facilities and take care of them as small kids. We provide the nutritive food to keep them healthy. We also give them the monthly required cosmetics such as soaps, oil, paste, brush...etc. We arrange Dhobi to wash their clothes. We have a dedicated Nurse Sister who is in charge of the home for the aged. If they are sick the immediate care is given and takes them to the nearby private hospital. Regular medicine is provided to the sick people. In the home we provide them necessary furniture to sit and relax. They even play indoor games and regularly watch the TV and relax. We have a big campus with variety of plants and flowers. They do even admire at the nature. We have regular prayers to strengthen them spiritually. We take care of the individual general hygiene. Some of the inmates help in doing vegetable cutting flocking the flowers.

From the time they joined in the Home for the Aged if they remain till their death we take care of them even in doing their funeral rights. Inmates are very happy and are ever faithful to the service of the sisters.

“Health is wealth” thus we provide wholesome food to keep them healthy. As they are advanced in their age mostly all are physically ill. So we provide free medical treatment. In an emergency we take them to the hospital with free of cost. Even when they are bedridden we take care of them intensively by giving sponge bath, and see all personal hygiene and all that they are need off. We also give them good clothing's to feel that they are dignified.



Taking care of hygiene and nutritional food. and also provided homemade snacks. Maintaining and manage Time.

Spiritually we take care of them by conducting prayers. Inmates attend the Daily Morning prayer at 6:30 AM then followed by mass. In the afternoon daily at 3:00 PM pray the Chaplet of mercy. In the evening at 5:30PM they pray Rosary. We arrange for the confessions. Aged persons are very much great full to us and daily they pray for our congregation.

Since it was lockdown due to the corona we could not go to their houses. In spite of lockdown the Physio doctor could teach the physio exercise to their mothers through the WhatsApp. Those who couldn't afford a smartphone, we visited their houses following Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) of Corona protocol.



Physiotherapy exercises have been done for children every month, which has strengthened the body. Passive stretching exercise and Active resisted exercise for strengthening, balancing exercise for sitting and standing, co-ordination exercises and walking training without any support.

Bags were distributed to every child in the tuition center for encourage them to study well with interest.



JMJSSS started our tuition center at Sembaruthimedu on July 2, 2021. After a prolonged lockdown, we have reopened our tuition centers so that our children could learn something more. We have four tuition centers around Kallidaikurichi. Then Sr.Rosy approached Village Reconstruction Organization (VRO).The VRO also came forward help the children. Then we started our tuition centers.The students were very eager to attend the tuition classes. We have around 200 children from L.K.G to 10thstd. We started the tuition centers in four places near kallidaikurichi(WestPotal, Northpotal, Sembaruthimedu and Atthiati street). It was very difficult to get the children focused on the lessons.
