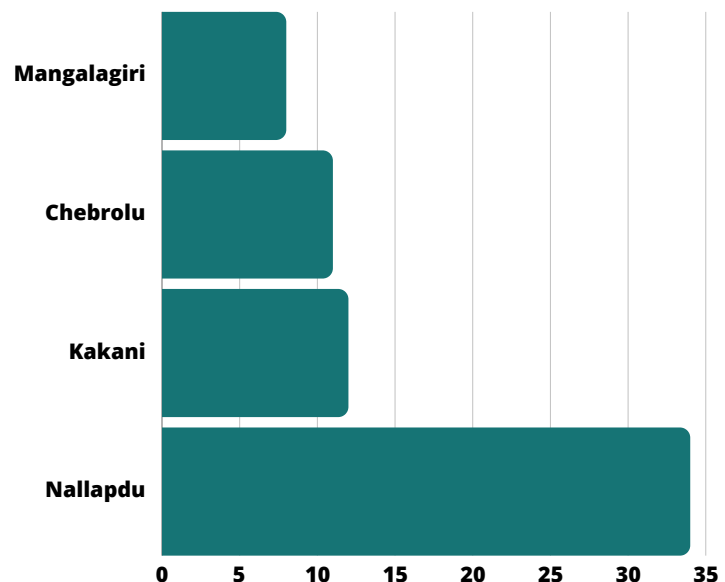
Orphan & Semi Orphan Children

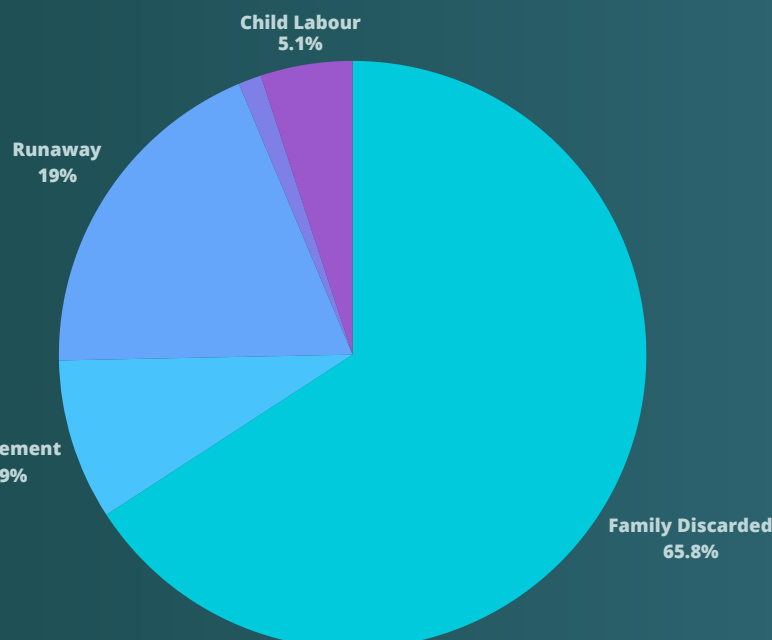

The CHILD HELP DESK – Ministry of Railways & WCD-CHILDLINEINDIA Foundation Implemented by JMJ Social Service Society, Nallapadu. CHILDLINE works for the protection of rights of all children aged from 0 to 18. It is an initiative for rescuing and assisting children in distress. The particular focus is on all children in need of care and protection, especially the more vulnerable sections and including Victims of child sexual abuse.

JMJSSS successfully rescued 374 children. These efforts highlight the critical role the helpdesk played in safeguarding children and addressing their immediate needs.

On 17th July 2023, JMJSSS stopped Child Helpdesk services. This decision came as a result of the central government's plan to integrate the services of the Child Helpdesk into the broader Mission Vatsalya Scheme.
